Parents will receive tips for talking to their children about relationships and online behavior, as well as how to provide support if their child is experiencing an unhealthy relationship. The age of consent in Canada will be looked at and discussed, as well as the many myths that are associated with consent. Many visuals such as video clips, scenario cartoons and graphs will be shown to further examine the ways in which teens view consent, and show solutions on the matter. This workshop in addition to discussing consent will give tips to parents who are working actively with their children, to educate them on the consent and healthy relationships matter both online and offline. We will explore boundaries, how to recognize bad signs in relationships, and that no simply means no!
