

Communicating with Trustees and Delegating the Board

Board Policy

1. Objective

- 1.1. The Halton District School Board (“HDSB”) values the input of residents of Halton and Halton-based organizations and commits to provide several ways for the public to communicate with the Board of Trustees (“Board”).
- 1.2. The Board will welcome residents of Halton to delegate on matters that require Board approval, including any item that will be voted on by Trustees within five weeks, or any matter of Board governance (e.g. policy).
 - 1.2.1. Delegations are an appropriate form of presentation for members of the public, but are not appropriate for employees of the HDSB or representatives of employee groups who wish to address matters related to their employment.
 - 1.2.2. Requests to delegate the Board are subject to the Communicating with Trustees and Delegating the Board Governance Procedure.
