SUBJECT: Notification of Boundary Review for south Milton/Milton SE #13 PS

Dear parent/guardian,

We are writing to inform you of the upcoming boundary review for the communities of south Milton schools. At the Feb. 7, 2024 Board meeting, Trustees of the Halton District School Board passed the motion below to initiate the process for a boundary review. Please note that you are receiving these notifications as **the outcome of this boundary review may result in your child(ren) moving schools.**

For south Milton communities (Map)

BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Halton District School Board direct staff to complete a boundary review for ERA 302 Bristol (formerly ERA 120) and ERA 304 Boyne (Formerly ERA 127) to integrate communities to their local school, establish new boundaries for Milton SE #13 ps, and balance enrolments at established schools for both the English and French Immersion programs.

Next Steps

A Boundary Review Steering Committee made up of trustees, senior administration, and planning staff will be established later this Spring to determine which consultation pathway will be undertaken for the review, confirm the schools involved and review the initial options, in accordance with the HDSB's School Boundary Review policy.

A Boundary Review Committee will be established in fall of 2024, to participate and provide feedback on the options. The option(s) will then be presented at a virtual public information session, details of which will be shared once the schedule has been finalized.

We expect this boundary review process to be complete by January 2025, with boundary change implementation starting as early as September 2025.
