

Review Process Timeline

Tuesday, November 8, 2011	<u>BRC</u> 1 st meeting to share BR process, provide overview of area under study, develop criteria to review scenarios, share/review initial scenarios. (7 – 9 pm in Small Board Room) BRC recommends revisions or changes to initial scenarios
Tuesday, November 15, 2011	<u>BRC</u> 2 nd meeting to review scenarios using criteria to measure the impact and effectiveness of each scenario. (7 – 9 pm in Small Board Room) BRC recommends revisions or changes to scenarios
Tuesday, November 22, 2011	<u>BRC</u> 3 rd meeting to review revised scenarios using criteria to measure the impact and effectiveness of each scenario (7 – 9 pm in MMR Theatre) BRC decides on recommended scenarios.
Tuesday, November 29, 2011	<u>BRC</u> 4 th meeting to review revised scenarios using criteria to measure the impact and effectiveness of each scenario (7 – 9 pm in Small Board Room) BRC decides on recommended scenarios to forward to Steering Committee for consideration and community consultation
Tuesday, December 6, 2011	<u>Public Consultation</u> – Steering Committee shares recommended scenario(s) with community for consultation (7 – 9 pm in MMR Gym)
Tuesday, December 13, 2011	<u>BRC</u> reviews community feedback and makes revisions and reaches consensus on a recommended option(s) (7 – 9 pm in Small Board Room)
Tuesday, December 20, 2011	<u>BR Steering Committee</u> receives report from the BRC, together with input from the community, and makes possible revisions to the recommendation(s)
Mon. January 9, 2012	Report & Recommendation(s) shared with Admin Council
Wed. January 18, 2012	Final Report & Director’s Recommendation(s) shared with Board
Wed. February 1, 2012	Board vote on Director’s Recommendation(s)
