Notice of Approval - South Milton & Milton SE #13 PS Boundary Review

Dear parents/guardians,

We are writing to inform you that Option 6a was approved by the Trustees of the Halton District School Board at the Jan. 7, 2025 Board meeting, as part of the <u>South Milton & Milton SE #13 PS Boundary</u> <u>Review</u>.

If your child is affected by these changes and is scheduled to move schools next school year (2025-2026), your child's current home school will contact you in the coming weeks to advise you that they will arrange for the transfer of your child(ren) to their newly assigned school for September 2025, as well as provide transition resources and support to help your family adjust smoothly.

Please note that there may be changes taking effect as early as today for **new** families registering and starting school after the effective date (see below for more information).

How does this impact my family?

Next steps

The new boundaries will be implemented over the next several years:

- Jan. 8, 2025:
 - New students registering in the HDSB and moving into **Zones 4, 5 and 6** will be assigned to their updated school catchment: **Tiger Jeet Singh PS**.
 - New students registering in the HDSB and moving into Zones 19, 20, 21, 22 and Milt13 will be assigned to their updated school catchment: Hawthorne Village PS.
 - The temporary redirection for **Zones 12, 13, 14 and Vio will be suspended for the year.** New students registering in the HDSB and moving into these zones will be directed to Viola Desmond PS.
- **September 2025:** Students who are transitioning for the 2025-2026 school year should review <u>Board Report 24158</u> and <u>Appendix D</u> for detailed planning. Communication regarding that transition will occur later this month.
