- A Boundary Review Process has been initiated to establish a boundary for Milton #7 PS in southeast Milton.
- The new school is planned to open in the 2013/2014 school year.

Purpose of Consultation Meeting

- Purpose of tonight's meeting is to solicit a response from the school communities regarding the four scenarios for the Milton #7 Elementary School and Implementation plan.
- To provide members of the public with an opportunity to provide feedback.
- Break out groups for each school community to review, discuss and comment on the four scenarios.
- Facilitator will be in each room taking notes and completing the comment forms.
- Maps and enrolment projections will be available in each room.

Boundary Review Process

- STEP 1 Boundary Review Steering Committee (BRSC) consisting of Board staff and trustees review enrolments, school capacities and programs. Initial boundary strategies are generated.
- STEP 2 Boundary Review Committee (BRC) established; consisting of members of the BRSC, Milton *Supercouncil and representatives from the affected school communities BRC engages in a process to give input in generating scenarios for consideration.
- *Supercouncil: Council of all School Council Chairs in Milton

Boundary Review Process Cont'd

- STEP 3 Boundary Review Steering Committee receives scenarios, and shares scenarios with community for information and feedback.
- STEP 4 Boundary Review Committee reviews community feedback, considers revisions, and makes recommendations to the Boundary Review Steering Committee.
- STEP 5 Boundary Review Steering Committee makes recommendation to the Director. Director takes recommended option to Trustees and/or may revise the recommended option prior to taking it to Trustees. Delegations to the Board occur within the timelines for the boundary review process. Board of Trustees make the final decision.



- To review community feedback and make recommendations to the Boundary Review Steering Committee.




The Boundary Review Process

- All 4 scenarios are available on the Board website (www.hdsb.ca).


CURRENT REGULAR TRACK BOUNDARIES

CURRENT SR FRENCH IMMERSION BOUNDARIES




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
