


- Feedback was open from September 29th to October 5th, 2020.

12 responses




Program (English, French Immersion)

Suggestions from the feedback:


- "Add FI to the new SW#1 High School to avoid sending the children all over the city."
- "Offering French Immersion at the new high school. There are a number of newer developments around the school (and south west Milton) to warrant the inclusion of the program, considering how far away the other French Immersion schools are."

For the BRSC to Consider:

- "Craig Kielburger is much easier to get to from our neighborhood than Milton District. There is a bike path almost all the way there as well so they can get to Craig Kielburger more safely on their own rather than working their way through town."
- Avoid separating cohorts.
- "Impact on students transferring to a different high school in the midst of their high school career."




